#### THE LORD'S DAY AT HOME


#### **Gospel Reading**

Matthew 14:22-33

Jesus made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead to the other side while he would send the crowds away. After sending the crowds away he went up into the hills by himself to pray. When evening came, he was there alone, while the boat, by now far out on the lake, was battling with a heavy sea, for there was a headwind. In the fourth watch of the night he went towards them, walking on the lake, and when the disciples saw him walking on the lake they were terrified. 'It is a ghost' they said, and cried out in fear. But at once Jesus called out to them, saying, 'Courage! It is I! Do not be afraid.' It was Peter who answered. 'Lord,' he said 'if it is you, tell me to come to you across the water.' 'Come' said Jesus. Then Peter got out of the boat and started walking towards Jesus across the water, but as soon as he felt the force of the wind, he took fright and began to sink. 'Lord! Save me!' he cried. Jesus put out his hand at once and held him. 'Man of little faith,' he said 'why did you doubt?' And as they got into the boat the wind dropped. The men in the boat bowed down before him and said, 'Truly, you are the Son of God.'

#### Reflection

As we said last week, every miracle is a message. So what is the message for us in this miracle of walking on the water? It might seem as though it serves no purpose (unlike the miracles of healing), but there is healing going on here. There is the healing of the doubts and fears of those who witness this miracle: notice how they are "terrified", thinking they are seeing a ghost! Jesus, from the water's surface, tells them not to be afraid. And when Peter (whose nickname means "rock"!) begins to sink like a stone because doubt overtakes him, Jesus reaches out his hand at once to heal his doubt. This miracle may have happened once in the past, but its message is to speak to us today. What are our fears? Where are our doubts? Let us call out to Jesus, and he will reach out at once to save us.

#### **Food for Thought**

#### A Simple Explanation of the Mass - Part X

After the Sign of Peace, we come in the Mass to the Breaking of the Bread. The priest takes the large host and breaks it into three or more parts. The meaning of the ritual is beautifully explained to us by St Paul in his First Letter to the Church at Corinth: "Is not the cup of thanksgiving for which we give thanks a participation in the blood of Christ? And is not the bread that we break a participation in the body of Christ? Because there is one loaf, we, who are many, are one body, for we all share the one loaf." (1 Corinthians 10:16-17). Despite its rich diversity, the Church is one as it gathers to celebrate our unity in Christ. Reflecting on the ritual of the breaking of bread, Father Cantalamessa, a preacher to the Papal Household says: "To understand this ritual, I must, first of all, 'break' myself... Lay before God all hardness, all rebellion towards him or towards others, crush my pride, submit and say 'yes' fully to all that God asks of me. I too must repeat the words: Lo, I have come to do thy will, O God! You don't want many things from me; you want me and I say 'yes'. To be Eucharist like Jesus signifies being totally abandoned to the Fathers will."
