THE LORD'S DAY AT HOME

If you are housebound or self-isolating at this time, please use these prayers to unite yourself with the worship of the Universal Church, and your own Parish, this Sunday. If alone, read or say these prayers quietly to yourself. If with another, or in a family, someone should read the Gospel, and others respond. It might be suitable to find a special, quiet place at home for your Sunday prayers.

Gospel

Matthew 21:28-32

Jesus said to the chief priests and the elders of the people, 'What is your opinion? A man had two sons. He went and said to the first, "My boy, you go and work in the vineyard today." He answered, "I will not go", but afterwards thought better of it and went. The man then went and said the same thing to the second who answered, "Certainly, sir", but did not go. Which of the two did the father's will?' 'The first' they said. Jesus said to them, 'I tell you solemnly, tax collectors and prostitutes are making their way into the kingdom of God before you. For John came to you, a pattern of true righteousness, but you did not believe him, and yet the tax collectors and prostitutes did. Even after seeing that, you refused to think better of it and believe in him.'

Reflection

Jesus really knows how to make a point! This is a wonderful example of him trapping the chief priests and elders into reinforcing his teaching even though they don't want to! The reference to 'tax collectors and prostitutes' must have really riled them! But perhaps the subtext would have annoyed them more: Jesus is saying they are the first son, who says all the right things but does not do his fathers will. The Pharisees, scribes and leaders of Israel might be saying the right things, as they preach the Law of Moses, but they are not doing the right things not repenting and listening to Jesus! Of course, the ideal is to bring both our words and deeds together this is integrity so that we both say 'Yes' to God and carry out his will.

A Simple Explanation of the Mass - Part XVII

What happens in us when we receive Holy Communion? 2) Holy Communion separates us from sin (#1393). The Catechism states: "The body of Christ we receive in Holy Communion is 'given up for us' and the blood we drink 'shed for the many for the forgiveness of sins.' For this reason the Eucharist cannot unite us to Christ without at the same time cleansing us from past sins and preserving us from future sins." This teaching will come as a surprise to many Catholics who associate the forgiveness of sins solely with the Sacrament of Penance. But upon reflection, we can easily see that if the Eucharist helps to increase our love for Christ, it must also keep us from the darkness of selfishness, which is sin. This is not to say that the Eucharist replaces our need for the Sacrament of Penance. It doesn't. Rather, it complements the work of sacramental reconciliation.
