When you thought I wasn't looking I saw you take care of our house and everyone in it, and I learned we have to take care of what we are given. When you thought I wasn't looking I saw how you handled your responsibilities, even when you didn't feel good, and I learned that I would have to be responsible when I grow up. When you thought I wasn't looking I saw tears come from your eyes, and I learned that sometimes things hurt, but it's all right to cry. When you thought I wasn't looking I saw that you cared, and I wanted to be everything that I could be. When you thought I wasn't looking I learned most of life's lessons that I need to know to be a good and productive person when I grow up. #### A Blessed Christmas Everyone!

A blessed Christmas everyone! Take a moment, pause and breath, and become aware that you are not alone, that God is with you at this very moment. You have no idea how long you have people in your life, so stop, pause, and remember that Jesus is in every one of your family members even if they drive you crazy. Breathe and take a moment to find Jesus inside of them. Thank God for each of them. And then, strengthen by the Miracle of the Holy Night in us, reach out to someone outside of your family. There are so many people who are poor or alone. Do something to make them feel less alone. Do something to make them feel loved. Treat them as if they were Jesus Himself, because they are! he came down from heaven:


**All bow:** and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man.
