



The Message of Easter

Jesus is nowhere visible. Yet the Easter Gospel tells us that Peter and John “saw and believed. What did they see? Burial shrouds lying on the floor of an empty tomb. But notice the repetition of the word “tomb”—seven times in nine verses. They saw the empty tomb and they believed what He had promised: that God would raise Him on the third day. Chosen to be His “witnesses,” the Apostles were “commissioned to preach and testify to all that they had seen—from His anointing with the Holy Spirit at the Jordan to the empty tomb. We are the children of the apostolic witnesses. That is why we still gather on the first day of every week to celebrate this feast of the empty tomb and give thanks for Christ our life. Baptised into His death and Resurrection, we live the heavenly life of the risen Christ. We are now His witnesses, too. But we testify to things we cannot see but only believe; we seek in earthly things what is above. We live in memory of the Apostles’ witness, like them eating and drinking with the risen Lord at the altar. And we wait in hope for what the Apostles told us would come—the day when we too “will appear with Him in glory.”
