

What's the future of synodality after the synod?

The synod's 400-some participants from six continents, including more than 350 voting delegates, have just spent four weeks in Rome and Vatican City. However, even though we have soon the final document and the synod is over, synodality is not over. While "synodality" has often been described in metaphors such as "walking together," the synod's final document aims to provide a clearer definition. "In simple and concise terms, synodality is a path of spiritual renewal and structural reform that enables the Church to be more participatory and missionary, so that it can walk with every man and woman, radiating the light of Christ," it states. The final document addresses a wide array of topics, including the responsibility of the baptised, the role of consultative bodies such as bishops' conferences, women's leadership in the church and the importance of missionary discipleship. Now that the assembly is over, it goes back to the local level. The preliminary Final Document is available for downloading on our Parish Websites.


