

#### THE IS COMING INTO OUR SOULS

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Together with Simeon and Anna we contemplate the Christ Child, the Word made flesh, who is brought to the Temple. That temple is not just the physical building but also the temple of our souls--that sacred space that is inside each of us. Today on this feast Christ is also presented to each of us, and it is up to us to open our doors and let his radiant light in. Today, forty days after the Lord's birth, we celebrate the coming of the Light of the World. This light is beautifully depicted by the yellow colour tonalities in our watercolour by Elizabeth Wang. We see the Holy Family from the back, about to walk up the steps, being greeted by Anna on the left and Simeon on the right. Note the smaller halo of Jesus in the arms of his mother set against her own halo. Beside the temple gate we see Anna on the left pointing towards the inside of the temple, whilst Simeon on the right has his arms outstretched, welcoming the Holy Family. At the centre of today's Gospel reading are two elderly people, Simeon and Anna. They were both blessed with the gift of recognition or insight. Both recognised the true identity of the child who was carried into the temple by his young parents. Simeon recognised Jesus as the light to enlighten the gentiles and as the glory of Israel. Anna recognised him as the deliverer for whom people had been waiting. They both went on to proclaim to others what they had come to recognise for themselves. Their gift of recognition was the fruit of their prayer. They were indeed people of prayer. Without prayer

they would not have recognised who Jesus truly was! In fact Simeon's prayer has become part of the Night Prayer of the church, as we recite his words as part of our Divine Office. The time we spend with the Lord in prayer makes it easier for us to recognise him when he comes to us through other people.



JUST FOR A LAUGH... Father Duncan's Sunday sermon was "Forgive Your Enemies." He asked how many of the congregation have forgiven their enemies? About half held up their hands. He then repeated his question. Now about 80% held up their hands. He then repeated his question once more. All responded, except one elderly lady. "Mrs. McGregor, are you not willing to forgive your enemies?" "I don't have any." "Mrs. McGregor, that is very unusual. Please tell the congregation how a person cannot have a single enemy in the world?" Mrs. McGregor replied, "I'm ninety-three-years-old and I outlived every one of those witches."

#### **BLESSING OF ST BLAISE ON MONDAY**

St. Blaise was a physician and Bishop of Sebaste, Armenia. He lived in a cave on Mount Argeus and was a healer of men and animals. According to legend, sick animals would come to him on their own for help, but would never disturb him at prayer. Agricola, governor of Cappadocia, came to Sebaste to persecute Christians. Blaise was arrested, and Agricola tried to get him to recant his faith. While in prison, Blaise ministered to and healed fellow prisoners, including saving a child who was choking on a fish bone; this led to the blessing of throats on Blaise's feast day. On his feast two candles are blessed with a prayer that God will free from all such afflictions and every ill all those who receive this blessing.

# EPIPHANY BLESSING IN THE MIDST OF DEVASTATION

Deadly wildfires have raged the Los Angeles area within the last week, leaving countless people without a home. The fires ravaged 40,000 acres, destroyed entire communities, and burned more than 12,300 structures. At least 24 people died as a result of the fires. Catholic author, radio host and evangelist Jesse Romero described one California homeowner's experience. A man told him he believes the Epiphany Blessing saved his home from burning to the ground. The man prayed the Epiphany Home Blessing on the Feast of the Epiphany, just before his family evacuated their Altadena home. "My friend took his family and all his kids, and they evacuated. He comes back home ... and guess what? As he looked around, every house around him was burned to the ground except his house. His house was unscathed. He did the Epiphany Blessing over the doors of his house on Monday before he was evacuated. And remember, the Epiphany Blessing is a prayer asking for divine protection for your house. Coincidence? No." Here's how someone responded: "We've done the Epiphany Blessing every year for many years. Four years ago, we had a very strong hail storm. I got to my house just before the hail got to our part of town. I prayed the prayer against storms in my front yard. Every single house in my neighbourhood had severe damage to their houses and roofs, except mine. My roof had minor damage to 10 slates!" In other prayers, prayer counts and if we trust



God we will do mighty deeds!






