Some Catholics today complain about the Mass in a constant litany: "Mass is boring." "The music is too old-fashioned." "I couldn't understand what the priest was trying to say." "The sound system is no good." "It went for too long." "I cannot relate to the priest." "The people at Mass are not my age." Maybe, just maybe, we are missing the point. It seems we have lost our sense of wonder. This is true in almost every area of our lives, but particularly when it comes to matters of faith and spirituality. We have lost the quintessential quality of childhood—wonder. It is about gathering as a community to give thanks to God for all the blessings he fills our lives with. Next Sunday, prepare yourself, be conscious of the marvel, the wonder, the mystery, and receive spiritually. Rediscover the wonder.
