

"Just Three Feet From Gold"



The expression "Just Three Feet From Gold" stems from a true story during the California Gold Rush era. It recounts the tale of a man who purchased a gold mine and started digging. After a period of frantic digging without finding any gold, the prospector became discouraged and sold the mine to someone else. The subsequent owner resumed digging and eventually found an abundance of gold, turning the mine into a highly profitable venture. He found the gold just three feet away from where the previous owner had been digging! This story can serve as a metaphor for our life of faith. Indeed, when we follow Jesus, there are times when we can feel discouraged, frustrated, or even ready to give up. There are moments when our prayers aren't answered immediately, causing us to question whether God is near. However, these moments may be the critical junctures where the answer to our supplications is just within our grasp. Difficulties and obstacles are often temporary and can be overcome with determination, patience and perseverance. By maintaining a positive mindset and a strong faith we can push through challenges and see God at work. This story also emphasises the importance of learning from obstacles and failures when it comes to evangelization. Instead of letting setbacks discourage us, we can embrace them as valuable lessons. Every challenge we face provides us with valuable knowledge and experience that we can use to bring others closer to Christ. Overall the story of "Just Three Feet From Gold" reminds us of the importance of trusting God, persevering through difficult times, and learning from the obstacles we face. It shows us that even in moments of discouragement and setbacks, the answers and blessings we seek may be much closer than we think. Let us demonstrate renewed faith in God's grace and power, persevering in prayer to overcome adversity and fulfil our purpose of guiding others to Christ.

"Every journey toward something is a journey away from something. If we need to turn back to God at this moment in our lives, we also need to turn away from whatever led us away from God and keeps us away. Whatever has distracted you, it is important to realise that you cannot journey to a new place and at the same time stay where you are. Walking with God demands that we bring order to our lives and put first things first."

LENT MEANS TO JOURNEY TOGETHER IN HOPE - MESSAGE OF POPE FRANCIS

"This Lent, as we share in the grace of the Jubilee Year, I would like to propose a few reflections on what it means to journey together in hope. **First of all, to journey.** A first call to conversion thus comes from the realisation that all of us are pilgrims in this life. Am I really on a journey, or am I standing still, not moving, either immobilised by fear and hopelessness or reluctant to move out of my comfort zone? **Second, to journey together**. The Church is called to walk together. Christians are called to walk at the side of others, and never as lone travellers. It means walking side-by-side, without shoving or stepping on others, without envy or hypocrisy, without letting anyone be left behind or excluded. This, then, is a second call to conversion: a summons to synodality. **Third, let us journey together in hope**, for we have been given a promise. May the hope that does not disappoint (cf. Rom 5:5), the central message of the Jubilee, be the focus of our Lenten journey towards the victory of Easter. May the Virgin Mary, Mother of Hope, intercede for us and accompany us on our Lenten journey." [Pope Francis]


