

The Miracle of Orvieto



In 1263 a German priest, Peter of Prague, stopped at Bolsena while on a pilgrimage to Rome. He is described as being a pious priest, but one who found it difficult to believe that Christ was actually present in the consecrated Host. While celebrating Holy Mass above the tomb of St. Christina, he had barely spoken the words of Consecration when blood started to seep from the consecrated Host and trickle over his hands onto the altar and the corporal. The priest was immediately confused. At first he attempted to hide the blood, but then he interrupted the Mass and asked to be taken to the neighbouring city of Orvieto, the city where Pope Urban IV was then residing. The Pope listened to the priest's account and absolved him. He then sent emissaries for an immediate investigation. When all the facts were ascertained, he ordered the Bishop of the diocese to bring to Orvieto the Host and the linen cloth bearing the stains of blood. With archbishops, cardinals and other Church dignitaries in attendance, the Pope met the procession and, amid great pomp, had the relics placed in the cathedral. The linen corporal bearing the spots of blood is still reverently enshrined and exhibited in the Cathedral of Orvieto. It is said that Pope Urban IV was prompted by this miracle to commission St. Thomas Aquinas to compose the Proper for a Mass and an Office honouring the Holy Eucharist as the Body of Christ. One year after the

miracle, in August of 1264, Pope Urban IV introduced the saint's composition, and by means of a papal bull instituted the feast of Corpus Christi. In August of 1964, on the 700th anniversary of the institution of the feast of Corpus Christi, Saint Pope Paul VI celebrated Holy Mass at the altar where the holy corporal is kept in its golden shrine in the Cathedral of Orvieto. Twelve years later, the same pontiff visited Bolsena and spoke from there via television to the 41st International Eucharistic Congress, then concluding its activities in Philadelphia. During his address Pope Paul VI spoke of the

SOLEMNITY OF THE NATIVITY OF JOHN THE BAPTIST ON TUESDAY

Only three birthdays are celebrated on the Church's liturgical calendar, the Nativity of Our Lord (December 25), the Nativity of His Mother Mary (September 8), and the Nativity of His forerunner, John the Baptist, on June 24. St. John the Baptist was set apart from the womb to prepare the way of the Lord and was a significant figure connected to the Incarnation and the Redemption. The Church honours him because of his role in preparing the way for Christ. John the Baptist was born to Saint Elizabeth and Zechariah. Elizabeth was a kinswoman of the Blessed Virgin Mary (Luke 1:36), making Jesus and St. John related. The most common term of relation suggested for the two is "cousin," though the exact degree is unknown.

■ Canonisation of Blesseds Acutis and Frassati

Pope Leo XIV will canonise Blesseds Carlo Acutis and Pier Giorgio Frassati together Sept. 7, the Vatican announced. Meeting with cardinals living in and visiting Rome for an ordinary public consistory June 13, the pope approved the new canonisation date for the two young blesseds and set Oct. 19 as the date for the canonisation of seven others. The canonisation of Blessed Acutis, a teenager known for his devotion to the Eucharist. Blessed Acutis used his tech skills to evangelise and was noted for his joyful faith and compassion for others before dying of leukaemia in 2006 at age 15. Blessed Frassati, born in 1901 was admired for his deep spirituality, love for the poor and enthusiasm for life. He served the sick through the St. Vincent de Paul Society. He died at age 24 after contracting polio, possibly from one of the people he assisted.

For those of you who have children and don't know it, we have a nursery downstairs.


