

Ninetieth Anniversary of Catholic School in Ardrossan



The photograph above is of Saint Peter's Primary School in South Crescent Road, Ardrossan, taken shortly before it closed on 13 October 1995. Sixty years earlier, it opened as Ardrossan's first Catholic school on 26 August 1935 and was called Ardrossan Central School. It accommodated both primary and junior secondary pupils, the latter from towns between Largs and Kilwinning. The building was originally Ardrossan Academy which opened on 2 October 1882 and closed on 19 June 1933 when pupils and staff transferred to the present building in Sorbie Road. Before the Central School opened, young Ardrossan Catholics were educated at Saint Mary's School in Springvale Street, Saltcoats. The first headmasteri of the 'new' school was Daniel Scullion and the teaching staff included Miss Baillie, Miss Canning, Miss Grant, Mrs Grant, Mr McAllister, Miss McCubbin, Mr McGrath, Mr Neill, Mr Prendergast and Mr Trayner. Mr Stephen Neill, an official of the Schools Association ran the football team. In 1935-1936, there were 270 primary pupils and 150 in the advanced division as the junior secondary department was then known. The local senior secondary school was Saint Michael's College in Irvine. In 1957, school uniform was introduced. It comprised a maroon blazer with the school badge, a maroon and turquoise striped tie and grey trousers or skirt. In 1960, the first ever school trip took place. All pupils and staff embarked on a special train at Ardrossan South Beach Station for Largs where they boarded the Maid of Skelmorlie for a cruise to Rothesay. The South Crescent Road building closed to pupils on 13 October 1995. Demolition started on I April 2004 and the site has lain derelict since then.

THE PASSION OF ST JOHN THE BAPTIST THIS FRIDAY


Season of Creation Conference in September
