

Make Your Baptism the Best Day of Your Life!




As we read about the baptism of Christ, it speaks to us today and reminds us of the realities that come from our own Baptism. What day were you baptised? You probably don't know. The greatest day of our lives, more important than our birthdays, wedding day, graduation day, or any other day, is clearly our baptismal day. Yet so few of us can recall what day of the year they were baptised and never think twice about it. But this is not so for a Christian who begins to understand what the grace of baptism means! Baptism in our lives of faith is profoundly meaningful. From the Second Vatican Council, we hear: We are all plunged into the paschal mystery of Christ: they die with Him, are buried with Him, and rise with Him; they receive the spirit of adoption as sons "in which we cry: Abba, Father" (Rom. 8:15), and thus become true adorers whom the Father seeks. (*Sacrosanctum Concilium*, 6) What does it mean to become part of the paschal mystery? It means we begin to participate in the life of Christ in such a way that our own personal lives are inserted into the very life of Jesus Christ. As Jesus took up the Cross in his own life and offered himself to the Father, so, too, does each one of us who takes up their cross and offers their life to the glory of God.

FEAST OF ST KENTIGERN ON TUESDAY

St Kentigern was a missionary and bishop during the 6th century. In Scotland, Kentigern founded a number of monasteries and churches including St Mungo's Cathedral in Glasgow. Kentigern was known for his commitment to the poor and needy. He was said to have given away all his possessions to the poor, and to have worked tirelessly to help those in need. He was also known for his wisdom and spiritual insight, and many people came to him for advice and counsel. Kentigern died on January 13, 603AD.

Ordinary Time begins after the feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which marks the closing of the Christmas season. The first few weeks of Ordinary Time occur during the winter, until it is interrupted by Lent and the Easter season. After the Easter season closes with Pentecost, Ordinary Time resumes and carries on through late spring until early winter with the beginning of Advent. Like all liturgical seasons, Ordinary Time calls us to reflect on particular mysteries of the faith in a more focused way than we would in other seasons. The Sundays and weeks of Ordinary Time, take us through the life of Christ. This is the time of conversion. This is living the life of Christ. Ordinary Time is a time for growth and maturation, a time in which the mystery of Christ is called to penetrate ever more deeply into history until all things are finally caught up in Christ.
